winemaker's notes

The slightly cooler temperatures of the Oak Knoll District have gained acclaim for producing some of Napa Valley's most refined Merlots. With its lush and captivating aromas, medium body texture, and long lasting finish, this wine is a prime example.

Notes of cranberry and licorice charm your senses as they mesh together to create an attractive candy aroma. On the palate, white pepper characteristics layer over the combination of red fruit, and dark chocolate flavors. Finely grained tannins create a dry finish, adding structure and sophistication to this elegant, estate grown Merlot-based blend.
