

## 2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*appellation* Napa Valley

*varietal* 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Merlot,  
2% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc, 1% Malbec

*alcohol* 14.5%

*bottling date* July 2015

*case production* 260 cases

*oak aging* 22 months in 85% new French Oak

### *winemaker's notes*

On the nose are aromas of black cherries, rhubarb, black currant, licorice, lavender, tobacco and dark fruits.

On the palate the wine carries a medium bodied weight with velvety integrated tannins. Dark fruits are abundant, along with pomegranate, raspberry, hints of sandalwood and a faint rose petal finish.

This wine is young and can age for some time if you want to cellar it. If you choose to open this wine up earlier we would recommend decanting the wine for 20 minutes and enjoying with friends and family.

Pair with cherry braised duck breast, BBQ glazed Wagyu beef, short ribs, pork loin and savory pasta dishes.
