Our estate grown rosé is the perfect balance of Malbec and Merlot, producing a beautiful light pink hue that resembles the cherry blossom flowers that adorn its namesake: Yoshino Mountain in Japan.

Juicy watermelon fills out the aromatic profile of this fun, zesty rosé, as softer notes of strawberry leap out of the glass.

The palate is uplifted by mouthwatering acidity to create a crisp, refreshing finish. The perfect wine to pair with brunch, or any warm weather occasion.
